## Curriculum

## School

The American School of Marrakesh offers a comprehensive four-year high school program in Grades 9-12. The school opened in September 1995 and graduated its first senior class in 2008. The American School of Marrakesh is fully accredited by the Middle States Association of Colleges & Schools and is officially recognized by the U.S. Department of State and the Moroccan government as one of five American schools in Morocco.

## GPA

Beginning in Grade 9, grades in all subjects are included in the GPA computation. A minimum of 28 credits is required for graduation. Certain electives are offered on a pass/fail basis. Additionally, all students are required to complete a 40-hour service learning requirement to graduate. AP and Seminar classes are weighted by one point. Honors classes are weighted by 0.3 points.
