#### Grade 10 IBDP Learning Plan Meetings (Tuesday 10:25 - 11:35am)

Grade 10 students will meet with the IBDP Coordinator individually to review and agree their learning plans for the IB Diploma Programme.

#### Upper School Sports & Water Activities (Wednesday 11:15am - 1:45pm)

A Field Sports & Water Activities Event will be held for all Grades 6 – 11 students, starting at 11.15am on Wednesday. The event is designed to foster positive sporting values, promote team-building and community spirit and celebrate the end of the academic year. During the afternoon, students will be maintained in their grade/class team 'bubble' and they will compete in a range of fun field and water activities against other grades/classes. If a student is not medically fit and therefore unable to participate, they will be required to provide a note from a parent or doctor. Students who are not able to participate will be assigned specific responsibilities in order to support the event (i.e. time-keeping, lap-counting, etc.) On Wednesday, all students should come to school dressed in their PE kit (trainers, socks, shorts, track/jogging pants, T-shirt, sweater), whilst still remaining in compliance with the school dress code as far as possible. They should be mindful that they will get wet during the water activities (during Block 3 for High School and during Block 4 for Middle School) and they should wear appropriate clothing and footwear and bring a towel.

All students will attend classes as per their usual schedule for Blocks 1 and 2. After Break 2 (at 11.15am), they will go to their Block 3 lesson, where they will register with their class teacher and then leave their belongings in the classroom before being escorted to the soccer pitches by their class teacher to join a warm-up before the activities start.

As the weather is likely to be hot, it is essential that all students ensure that they are equipped with the following:

- Water Bottle
- Sun Hat
- Sun Lotion
- Towel

#### Upper School End of Year Exams (Thurs 10th, Fri 11th & Mon 14th June)

In order to ensure the exams are fair, all students will be required to complete them via Distance Learning from home. Students will not be required to come to campus.

Students will need to use the Google Classroom access code on the schedule in order to join the Google Classroom for all of their exams. They will also need to join the Google Meet using the Grade-specific Google Meet link for every exam.

Students are scheduled to take TWO exams per day. End of year assessments are given in the following subjects: Mathematics, English, Science, Social Studies, Arabic and French. In order to access the exam, students must join the Google Meet at the indicated exam start time.

- Middle School (G6-8) Exams are up to 1 hour and 30 minutes.
- High School (G9-12) Exams are up to 2 hours.

All exams will be open note/open book/calculator permitted tests\*.

\***PLEASE NOTE:** for some subjects, end of year assessments may be project-based. Class teachers will inform students and parents about the details of the project-based assessment (i.e. date for submission of project) and this information will also be posted in the Grade-specific Exams Google Classroom.

Any student who misses exams during the schedule will be required to provide a medical certificate and to complete the exam **on the Makeup Test day** - **this must be arranged with Ms Laila AND the subject teacher**. **It is the responsibility of the student to arrange the** 

**make-up test.** Students who miss the regularly scheduled exam time and the make-up exam time will receive a 0 (zero).


#### What if something goes wrong?
