COMMUNITY

The American School of Marrakesh is an independent, college preparatory school unified by our core values of Integrity, Responsibility, Respect and Excellence. The student body is culturally diverse with a population that self-identifies as Moroccan, American, French, and more than a dozen other nationalities. Our team is composed of a diverse group of educators, specialists, support staff and instructional leaders who bring a wealth of experience and know-how to our school. Our teachers are experts in their fields who possess professional certification and/or advanced degrees in their area of expertise.

SCHOOL

ASM offers a comprehensive PK-12 program to 430 students with a rigorous curriculum in grades 9-12 that prepares 100 students for research-university levels of higher education. ASM opened in September 1995 and graduated its first senior class in 2008. The American School of Marrakesh is fully accredited by the Middle States Association of Colleges & Schools. ASM is recognized as an International Baccalaureate World School offering the bilingual IB Diploma Programme, and is officially recognized by the U.S. Department of State and the Moroccan government as one of five American schools in Morocco.

CURRICULUM

The American School of Marrakesh offers an American curriculum based on the American Education Reaches Out Standards (AERO) from prekindergarten to Grade 12. The academic program is delivered in English and includes six core courses (English, math, science, history, Arabic and French) and a selection of electives. Students are involved in a wide array of co-curricular and service learning activities. All students work towards obtaining an American High School Diploma and can choose to earn the full IB Diploma or a few course certificates.

GRADES & GPA

Beginning in Grade 9, grades in all subjects are included in the GPA computation, except for transfer credits. Transfer credits from schools not issuing grades in the US letter grade system will be labeled as PASS/FAIL courses. A minimum of 27 credits is required for graduation. Certain electives are offered on a pass/fail basis.

SERVICE LEARNING

All students must complete a 40-hour service learning requirement as part of the graduation criteria. For those enrolled in the IBDP program, this requirement is fulfilled through CAS (Creativity, Activity, and Service), a core component of the IB curriculum.
